Notice is hereby given to the eligible electors in Hancock County, Iowa that the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION in Hancock County, State of Iowa, will be held at the regular polling places in each of the 10 voting precincts of Hancock County on Tuesday, November 4, 2025.

City of Klemme Public Measure JG:

Shall the following public measure be adopted?

Shall the City of Klemme, in the County of Hancock, State of Iowa, be authorized to adopt an Ordinance Repealing and Replacing Section 21.02 of the City Code? The proposed ordinance would alter the composition of the Library Board of Trustees to reduce the number of trustees from six resident members and one non-resident member (total of seven), to four resident members and one non-resident member (total of five).

Iowa Central Community College Public Measure VT:

Shall the following public measure be adopted?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Iowa Central Community College in the Counties of Boone, Buena Vista, Calhoun, Carroll, Cherokee, Clay, Crawford, Franklin, Greene, Hamilton, Hancock, Humboldt, Ida, Kossuth, Palo Alto, Pocahontas, Sac, Webster and Wright, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation bonds to provide funds to remodel, improve, repair, construct, erect, furnish, and equip buildings and additions to buildings for educational and workforce training, to make improvements to sites and acquire land, to contract indebtedness therefore, and issue its school bonds in an amount not exceeding \$35,000,000 for those purposes?

This notice of the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION is given by order of the Hancock County Commissioner of Elections in compliance with the laws of Iowa.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by November 10, 2025 at 12:00 p.m. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
